Suspect a gas leak? Here's what to do.

Natural gas leaks are rare, but it's important to know the warning signs and how you should respond.

- **Smell** – A “rotten egg” odor added to natural gas
- **Listen** – Hissing near appliances or blowing near gas lines
- **Look** – Blowing dirt, bubbling water, or dead plants in an otherwise green area

If you suspect a leak, **leave the area immediately and call Liberty at 1-800-673-3301 or 911 from a safe distance.**
